# **IMPORTANT!**

- The area of application for this industrial SpeedRoller door is set out in EN 13241
- Upon operating the door, the qualified expert must check for potential hazards and satisfy himself that the door is balanced and functioning properly and can be operated by hand as per FN 12604 and FN 12453
- Maintenance should be performed at least every year or 100,000 cycles.
- Annual maintenance that is not carried out by a qualified service centre using original parts, will void the warranty. (Please ask your dealer).

#### 1.1 General instructions

- Read the installation manual thoroughly before beginning to install the product! Note all comments and take the safety and warning instructions very seriously!
- Make sure that the generally applicable legal and other mandatory regulations for accident prevention and environmental protection, national regulations and approved technical regulations for safe and proper execution of the work are respected.
- The qualified expert is responsibile for checking if the supplied fixing materials are suitable for the building's structure.
- Keep to the sequence given in the assembly drawings!
- Always use the correct tools!
- Only perform work on the industrial door when the door is put out of service.
- Pay special attention to the dangers that can arise when tensioning the springs: use special tools!
- Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or material damage!
- The used components are manufactured from high quality, durable and solid materials. Nevertheless, during the installation of the door caution is necessary to avoid damage.

 Replace any defective parts by original spare parts only, otherwise the safe and proper operation of the door can not be guaranteed. Also, the warranty is no longer available!

#### 1.2 Opening construction and mounting

Install the SpeedRoller door on a steel or concrete structure that is strong enough to support the forces of wind. Installation on masonry, plaster concrete etc. is strongly discouraged. It is recommended to build a solid steel frame first.



# Warning

- When mounting the door, parts could fall down, causing injury to persons and damage to objects. Fix the side guides and the top roll carefully when you start assembling.
- When working with high voltage there is a risk of electrocution. Make sure that the electrical installation at the customer complies with the applicable safety requirements.
- Turn off the power before any installation work and secure it against unauthorized switching on. Disable - if presentthe lever for emergency opening.
- Never apply high voltage to the control unit, this will lead to irreparable damage to the electronics.
- Only perform welding and grinding work when it is expressly permitted on the current location. A fire or explosion hazard may exist! Provide adequate ventilation for welding or grinding to prevent the explosion of dust and other combustible materials.

#### 1.3 Tolerances

All parts are produced to standard tolerances with the utmost care. The standard tolerance for steel parts is  $\pm 2$  mm, and for aluminium  $\pm 1$  mm. The maximum tolerance for assemblies is the sum of the tolerances for the various materials.

#### 1.4 Operating Test

- After completing the installation, operation of the door must be checked using the Delivery checklist in the User manual.
- Fill out the Delivery checklist truthfully and sign it.
- Pass this Installation manual together with the User manual and other documentation to the customer.

- Do not modify the software of the programmable control system.
- Modification or extension of the product only by the supplier.

# Warning

Movements of the door can hurt people or damage objects.

#### 2.2 Preliminary remarks:

- Do not trail the top roller over the ground
   During the installation, place the top
- During the installation, place the top roller on a clean surface
- Do not step on the cloth (door panel)!
- The following instructions apply to standard SR Strong Outdoor doors



2.3 The Strong Outdoor consists of the following main sections:




- The top roller: a door roller surrounded by a plastic door panel (cloth) and a bottom beam.
- Two columns that support the top roller and guide the door panel.
- A control box and the slip-on door drive.
- A tube wit the lightcurtains and abox with further small parts.

When installing multiple doors you must carefully sort all components! Report any transport damage immediately to Novoferm Netherlands BV.

























Mount the consoles hand-tight to the columns (1 X per column).

- Bearing side > fixed > with lock bolt M12x40 and flange nut M12
- Drive side > hand-tight > with lock bolt M12x40, rubber washer and flange nut M12


Take into account the height difference between a1 and a2!







Place wall guides upright and clamp them to the wall with adhesive clamps. Make sure that the consoles are level with each other.






B inside measurement = clear width on the order form.

Note: this may vary from the actual clear width of the building!

The inside measurement [B1 and B2] must be the same at each height.











Secure the wall sides of the columns hand-tight to the wall with 1 bolt and washer.


Note: only use the 3rd hole from below.







The slotted holes in the skeleton correspond to the holes in the columns, see detail 4.8a and 4.8b.









Mount the wall side of the wall guides with the skeleton **hand-tight** to the wall.


\* Allow the sliding strips to extend as long as possible, just as the available space allows. If there are no obstacles, you can leave the sliding strips long.








Place the separate upper pulleys hand-tight in the upper slotted holes (left and right)








Make sure the columns are completely level and secure them permanently.




Snap the supplied light curtain to the inside of the columns (see 4.11b). Position the **Transmitter** (SG-**T**) of the light curtain on the wall guide **opposite** the control. Position the **Receiver** (SG-**R**) of the light curtain on the wall guide **where the control is located**.






Slide the transmitter and receiver side of the light curtain down into the supplied clips until the spacers on the underside of the light curtain are on the floor.

Please make sure that both sides of the light curtain are aligned exactly horizontal.








Drill a hole through the sliding strip at the next bracket above the light curtain.











Attach the enclosed 20 x 20 mm cable duct(s) to the wall as indicated. Use the included screws. The top of the cable duct must be parallel to the top of the wall guides.







Feed the light curtain cable through the hole and fasten the cable with a cable duct on top of the bracket as indicated.














Route the light curtain cable along the upper pulley bracket and through the upper angled cable duct to the horizontal cable duct.






Place the supplied cable edge protection strip in the upper recess of the wall guide. **Drive side only!** 








Ensure proper cable routing to the control box, e.g. with a  $40 \times 40$  mm wiring channel. Make sure that the edge protection strip is correctly positioned in the guide (see 4.16).






Fit the lock bolts and rubber rings to mount the top roller from the inside out.











The top roller is delivered complete. Raise the top roller with a forklift truck and slide the axles into the consoles.












Make sure that the winding pulleys are within the consoles and that the left and right sides of the consoles are sufficiently spaced to allow them to rotate freely.








#### The rubber rings can be removed.

Slide the flange bearing from the outside onto the axle and secure the flange bearing by hand with the lock bolts and self-locking flange nuts provided.






Roll up the door leaf all the way. Align the upper roller and drive horizontally, so that the widest part of the upper roller is 5 mm away from the rear slide strip. Now tighten both flange bearings.






#### The rubber rings can be removed.

Hand-tighten the engine mount to the console and to the wall guide with the lock bolts and flange nuts. Slide the axle key in the axle keyway.
















Then attach the drive to the engine mount.

Use the M12 lock bolts and flange nuts (2 X).


Roll the elastic bands all the way off the aluminium winding disc.









Roll the elastic band back onto the winding disc one revolution. The elastic band must be rolled in the opposite direction to the door leaf so that it is pulled upwards.








Temporarily remove the light curtain on the bearing side. Snap the light curtain out of the mounting clips and unscrew the bottom clip. Attention: the clip and the light curtain have to be re-assembled later!









Remove the lower part of the skeleton left and right. To do so, unscrew the lower 4 taptites from the brackets.

Attention: do not throw these taptites away, they will be needed again later!






Loosen the front clamping plates by loosening one bolt and unscrewing one bolt all the way out (L + R).






Guide the elastic bands along the upper two pulleys as indicated.






Guide the rubber bands under the lower pulley. Point the eye towards the threaded end of the lower beam (L + R).







Clamp the elastics between the clamping plates and secure the clamping plates with all four bolts  $(\mathbf{L} + \mathbf{R})$ .





Roll the cloth down to between the lower 2 brackets.




Ensure that the distance between the hook and the guide is the same on both sides.

See top view: X1 = X2






Slide the bottom beam over the curtain tendon as shown.








Centre the bottom beam: X1 = X2!








Pull the curtain forward and drill a hole in the curtain on the left, at the level of the hole in the bottom beam. Make sure that the bottom beam is still neatly centred. X1 = X2.








Pull the curtain forwards and drill a hole in the curtain on the right at the level of the hole in the bottom beam.






Secure the bottom bar on the left with the supplied M6 x 10 taptites.






Secure the bottom bar on the right with the supplied M6  $\times$  10 taptites.






Bend the sliding strips forward (1) so that the door curtain can be hung back into the guides. Then lower the bottom beam all the way down (2).







Slide the eye of the elastic band over the threaded end of the bottom beam. Do this on both sides (**left and right**).





Slide the M8 washer over the threaded end, and secure the elastic band by hand with the self-locking M8 nut. Tighten the nut until it sits completely on the threaded end, so that the nut is secured. Do this on both sides (**left and right**).













Remove the  $\mbox{\it left}$  and  $\mbox{\it right}$  clamps holding the elastic bands.









Roll up the curtain to 1.5 M. from the floor.




Reattach the lower parts of the skeleton to their original position.







Replace the clip and the light curtain on the bearing side.







Hook the left and right cover panels into the columns. Insert the clamps into the recesses provided and slide the cover panels downwards until they snap into place.















The inlay profile must be mounted horizontally against the wall. The height is 80 mm from the rear edge of the consoles (See detail). Determine the correct position accurately!














The inlay profile must be centred horizontally in relation to the columns (X1 = X2). Always use the supplied mounting kit to mount the inlay profile against the wall.








































































































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
